Why are we running the programme?

We are aware that coaches are put under pressure from players and parents nominate their son.

We ask that you are fair to the players involved by ensuring that only appropriate players are put forward to prevent later disappointment.

The primary criteria that we are looking for is those players who are 'ready to engage with a challenging development programme' that is: they are keen to better themselves, very committed to what they do and will add value to others in the DPP

You can nominate <u>UP TO</u> 4 players.

A deep engagement and passion for the game.

An outstanding level of commitment and effort

Technical Tactical

The ability to have a significant impact on the game when playing with peers

A high level of skill compared to peer group

Physical

Potential
The potential to demonstrate physical qualities necessary to play a high level and/or high levels of athleticism

These will be players who stand out above their peers as those who have the most influence the game

This is the least important category, but at this age these players may be faster or more agile than their peer group
