


Q2 What is your age?







Q4 What areas of the game are you involved in currently? Tick all that apply





Q5 What are the most important factors to you in being involved with Rugby Union? Tick all that apply








Q9 How engaged do you feel with your local RFU delivery team/community rugby coaches


Q10 Do you know that Leicestershire has a representative on the RFU Council, and do you understand what their role is within the game?
